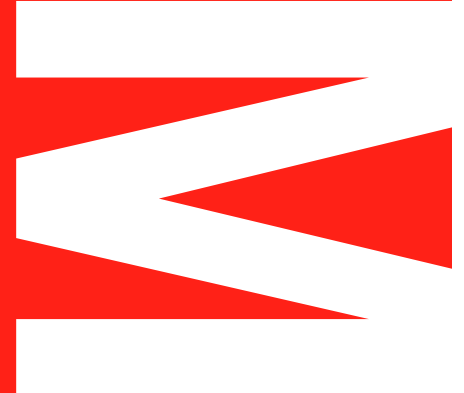

A Profile

District Governor **Emma Martinez Nava, PHF** is the 20th governor of District 3850. She is also 3850's second female district governor.

Governor Ems brings to the District 33 years of experience in Rotary service to her club and the district. She was a Charter Member of the Rotary Anns of the Rotary Club of Iloilo City, where she actively functioned either as director, vice president, or president.

Ems hails from the well-known Martinez clan of Malabon. She completed her grade school, high school, and A.B. Economics degree at Maryknoll College (now Miriam College) in Quezon City. It was in Metro Manila where she met a university student who would be her future husband, Oscar.

After getting married, the Nava couple decided to raise their family in Iloilo City where gainful employment and business opportunities abound. For the next 16 years, Ems worked as office manager of RJL Martinez Fishing Corp. and the Western Visayas Shipbuilding and Repair Co., Inc.

As a licensed real estate broker, Ems is a unit manager of a real estate development corporation while heading some family businesses. She is president of EOS Property Holdings, Inc., treasurer of Lemon Tree Enterprises and Paradise Island Multi Resources.

She is also chairperson of the board of trustees of Tayben Woodland Foundation, Inc. DG Ems is treasurer of the annual city government's Committee for Christmas Décor that is responsible for sourcing lanterns that inmates design and construct to brighten the city during the Yuletide Season.

All in the Family

The Navas are, by choice and dedication, a Rotary Family.

Oscar "Oca" Caram Nava Jr., PHF, a businessman and sportsman, is a Charter Member and Past President of the Rotary Club of Iloilo City. He was District 3850 Governor in RY 1997-98.

Oca and Ems, as a couple, are a major contributor to The Rotary Foundation.

All four of their children are **Paul Harris Fellows**. **Pia Angela, PHF** is a past club secretary of RC Central Iloilo City, former president of the Interact Club of Metro Iloilo, a Rotex to RI District 7260 in Long Island, NY. Pia

finished her AB Mass Communications degree at Assumption College in San Lorenzo Village, Makati City.

Oscar Reuben, PHF is an Industrial Design graduate of De La Salle University – College of Saint Benilde. He had his senior high school year as a Rotex to District 6670 in Ohio. **Amanda Joanna, PHF**, is a Production Design graduate also of De La Salle University - College of Saint Benilde. She was a Rotex to District 7750 in Clemson, South Carolina. Not to be outdone by her siblings, Alyssa, the youngest, is going to District 7910 in Needham, Massachusetts. **Alyssa Maria, PHF**, just graduated from high school at Assumption, Iloilo.

Service to Rotary

Like any club executive, then President Ems saw to fruition vital projects that touched the lives of children and generally the socially and economically challenged communities in the City and Province of Iloilo.

Governor Ems is particularly proud of the club's water impounding project in a depressed barangay in Janiuay, Iloilo that is home to a small community of Aetas ("Ati") and the literacy program for these indigenous people that inspired the active involvement of the Special Education Students Association (SPEDSA) headquartered at the West Visayas State University. Totally sold to the idea of service the Rotary way, the Ati elders welcomed their formation into the Janiuaynon Aetas Rotary Village Corps.

From the early 1990s all the way to this new century, Governor Ems has had the honor of having the trust of district governors who asked her to head important subcommittees and committees. Even before becoming club president, Ems already co-chaired the Panay Partner in Service of the District Rotary Foundation. She chaired the TRF Alumni Subcommittee for five straight years from 1998 to 2003 and again in RY 2006-07 when she was able to organize the Rotary Foundation Alumni Association of Panay. She served as AG under District Governor Philip "Phil" Abello and District Secretary under District Governor Benjamin "Boy" Jarantilla.

In RY 2004-05, Governor Ems was head of District Extension and chair of the Rotary Youth Exchange Committee the following Rotary Year. In RY 2005-2006, under DG Eric Laviña Jr. she was chosen to lead the GSE Team bound for India.

Service as District Governor. DG Emma's service work is cut out for the coming Rotary Year 2008-2009. She is not alone. With her family and her team, as well as the support of the past district governors, club officers, and Rotarians, RI District 3850 will **Make Dreams Real**.

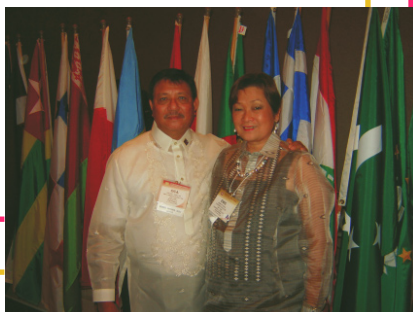

If you have a special story to tell about a project your club has successfully carried out – we would like to know!

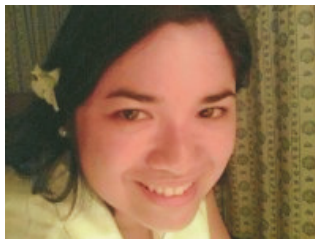
If you would like to contribute brief items of news, events or stories of personal achievement – get in touch!

PHOTO ESSAY CONTEST RULES

1. The contest is open to Rotarians only.
2. Entries should be submitted by email with a resolution of at least 180dpi in jpeg format.
3. Subject should be in line with the Rotary International theme Make Dreams Real, focusing on RI President DK Lee's thrust to reduce child mortality through literacy, health and hunger, and water.
4. Images may feature children and/or subject matter which illustrate literacy, health and hunger, and water.
5. Two entries will be selected each month for the next six months, from August to January inclusive, and published in the GML. All 12 finalists' entries will be included in the photo exhibit during the Discon, and published in the February edition of the GML.
6. A panel of judges will select the monthly finalists, and the top three winners will be announced at the Discon.
7. Entrants may submit as many images as they like, but no more than one image from any individual will be selected among the 12 finalists.
8. Entries submitted for any month which are not selected as one of the two monthly finalists must be resubmitted if they are to be considered for the next month's judging.
9. Any photos entered for the competition, whether or not they are selected as finalists, may be published or used by the district for any promotional materials or Rotary fundraising without compensation to the photographer. The name of the Rotarian will be duly credited.
10. The deadline for submission of entries is the 1st of each month. All entries should be emailed to photocontestd3850@gmail.com and include the entrant's full name, address, contact details (phone number or email address) and the name of the Rotary Club to which they are affiliated.
11. Entries will be judged on the following criteria:
 - a. Overall visual impact (50%)
 - b. Technical achievement, creativity and composition (50%)
12. Prizes will be awarded to the top three entries and credited towards their The Rotary Foundation (TRF) contribution as follows:

1st Prize	:	\$ 250
2nd Prize	:	\$ 150
3rd Prize	:	\$ 100
13. Certificates will be awarded to all 12 finalists.
14. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Profile

Dong Kurn Lee, a Rotary Foundation trustee and a member of the Rotary Club of Seoul Hangang, Seoul, Korea, is the selection of the Nominating Committee for President of Rotary International in 2008-09. Lee is chair of the Bubang Co. Ltd. and Bubang Techron Co. Ltd. manufacturing companies in Seoul and formerly served as a trustee of the Bank of Seoul. In 2005, he was appointed an international goodwill ambassador by the president of Korea.

Lee has also served as honorary consul to the Italian consulate in Korea since 1994 and was awarded the Order of Industrial Merit by the Korean government. He and his wife, Young Ja, have two sons and two daughters.

A Rotarian since 1971, Lee has served RI as a director, treasurer, district governor, training leader, regional Rotary Foundation coordinator, and membership task force coordinator in Asia. He began his tenure on the Foundation's Board of Trustees in 2003-04 and is a recipient of the Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service.

Dear fellow Rotarians,

The beginning of the Rotary year is always an exciting time, with new club and district officers, a new theme to work with, and a renewed sense of purpose for our service projects. The beginning of this particular Rotary year is, of course, especially exciting for me as I look forward to meeting Rotarians throughout the world and seeing firsthand the many remarkable projects you are carrying out.

In planning how your club, and each one of you, can Make Dreams Real this year, I ask you to consider the millions of children who never even have the chance to dream. Every day, more than 26,000 children under the age of five die from preventable causes. As appalling as that number is, it is a decrease from the figure of 30,000 that first caught my attention and spurred me to bring this matter of grave concern to Rotarians.

UNICEF's State of the World's Children 2008 report states that "by 2006, the most recent year for which firm estimates are available, the annual number of child deaths globally fell below 10 million, to 9.7 million, for the first time since records began." I would guess that some of the improvement in child survival rates can be directly attributed to Rotary projects that have been successfully addressing problems related to health, hunger, water, and literacy for a number of years now. So I asked myself: "What would happen if 1.2 million Rotarians focused their service efforts on keeping even more children alive?"

I think we already know some of the answers. If Rotarians provide insecticide-treated bed nets, fewer children will succumb to malaria. If we dig wells and address sanitation problems, more children will have clean water to drink and more hygienic surroundings. And if Rotary clubs carry out effective nutrition projects, we can save some of the almost five million children who die each year from undernourishment.

UNICEF estimates that fully two-thirds of the 9.7 million deaths in 2006 were preventable. With Rotarians working to provide vaccines, oral rehydration therapies, accessible health care for mothers and newborns, and other relatively simple interventions, I'm confident that many more babies will not only survive but go on to live healthy, productive lives. Let's Make Dreams Real by giving these children the chance to grow up and have dreams of their own.

CHANGING OF THE GUARDS

Every year a new RI President, a new District Governor, new District Officers and new set of Club Officers inspired by a new theme.

This year's theme RY 2008-2009 is Make Dreams Real.

The thrust of RI President Dong Kurn Lee is focused on reducing child mortality through LITERACY, HEALTH and HUNGER, and WATER.



LITERACY

Educate the children to better equip them in their future and break the cycle of poverty through:

1. Mentoring the mentors. Training teachers to be more proficient in English;
2. Supplying students with reading materials and dictionaries;
3. Holding RYLA for the 13-15 year olds.

This youth camp is envisioned to be a joint service project. There is nothing like seeing kids inspired and guided by the new prospective of living life outside of the realm of poverty.

HEALTH AND HUNGER

1. Feeding programs for the pre-elementary students. Coordinate with the city/provincial health officers in the proper way of conducting a feeding program on long term basis.
2. Supplying public health centers with anti-tetanus vaccines for pregnant women. This would reduce incidence of child mortality at birth. Check out the Department of Health/Regional Hospitals for supplies.
3. Proper sanitation: conduct a survey on public schools & nursery centers which do not have toilets. Ensure that the septic tank system will not contaminate water supply to avoid water borne diseases.

WATER

1. Survey public schools/nursery centers without water supply. Donate water filters.
2. Install a water system in the community by supplying manual water pumps.

The tasks look burdensome and overwhelming from the point of view of individual clubs. However, together as one District, we can achieve all these!

With over 50 clubs, working together or in tandem, we will MAKE DREAMS REAL in a very significant manner to the greatest number of those whom we aim to help!

Congratulations! I am looking forward to working with you in making dreams a reality.

P.S.

With the recent devastation brought by typhoon Frank, Rotarians were not amiss in their duty to help--to be of service. I have actually experienced the selfless dedication of a number of Rotarians. They were there even before the government declared a state of calamity for the city and the province. They were there rescuing stranded Rotarians, delivering food and water to those whose homes were flooded up to the ceiling. Yes, they were there distributing towels and dry clothes and crying out for help from fellow Rotarians and from friends.

District 3850 salutes those Rotarians. You know who you are.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Clubs should be in good standing with Rotary International, i.e. Clubs do not have an outstanding obligation with R.I. to include SAR dues, The Rotarian and/or The Philippine Rotary Magazine. (Clubs should submit official receipts of SAR & PRM as of July 2008 and January 2009)
2. Clubs should be in good standing with the District, i.e. Clubs have paid governors fund and have submitted required reports to the District (such as M.A.R., etc.).

As one of the major thrusts of RI Pres. D.K.Lee and our own Gov. Emma Nava, literacy will be the Rotary year's catchword and work focus!

Whilst the target of our literacy activities is the youth, literacy for prevention of child mortality expands our focus to all ages. For our District, activities and projects may take on varying forms:

- Book for students
- Training students
- Training Trainors
- Health Training for Mothers

What makes literacy projects unique is that these can be sustainable and not just another new project for this Rotary year.

Thus, for purposes of sustainability DG Ems suggests that clubs undertake joint projects. To further ensure long-term success of your literacy projects, adopt a school or a school district, depending on the type of projects. For example if your project involves books or training students, adopting a school for this purpose is most advised; then plan activities that are congruent with this. On the other hand, training the trainors will involve teachers from within a school district or city. Training programs involve the creation of syllabi or training modules; these involve inviting facilitators to ensure program effectivity.

As you undertake your literacy projects, this column will endeavor to assist you and your club. Please put whatever questions or clarifications needed for direct response. Let's make this an interactive column to share our experiences with the District!

FOR THE LOVE OF READING

My love affair with books began at an early age. I remember my parents reading to me at bedtime: Cinderella and Snow White; the exotic tales of the Arabian Nights; Bible stories for children; wacky Dr Seuss's Cat in the Hat series... all these and more captured my imagination. I also loved my book of nursery rhymes. To this day, I can still recite almost all of them by heart.

Then there was Nancy Drew, my favourite sleuth. Mom got me interested in her; in fact she passed on several of her hardbound copies to me. Mom said in her youth she would spend her summers reading Nancy Drew, Hardy Boys and The Bobbsey Twins. Detective stories cultivate an analytical mind, she would tell me.

I remember when the MV Doulos, the biggest floating library in the world, came to the port of Iloilo. I was in book heaven! Mom and I had a field day going over tons of books and buying as much as we could carry.

As I got older, Mom urged me (a nicer way of saying she nagged me to death!) to read more relevant material such as Time magazine, Newsweek and National Geographic so that I would be informed as to what was going on in the world. Fantasy and make believe stories were all good for the imagination, she said, but it was equally important to balance fiction with a dose of reality.

Another aspect to reading is its penchant for improving one's vocabulary and spelling skills. I would often come across new words and ask Mom what they meant. As always, she would say: "Look it up!" I would grumble, too lazy to check the word in the dictionary, and plead with her to tell me – since she knew the meaning anyway! But she would not budge. Eventually, I got into the habit of looking things up. Now, I find myself telling my 16-year-old sister to *look it up* when she asks me for the meaning of an unfamiliar word.

In high school, I discovered Roget's Thesaurus. It is a treasure trove of fancy and lesser used words that came in handy when I wanted to make my writing assignments sound more intelligent! Reading and writing go hand in hand. And, from personal experience, reading has made me a better writer.

On a final note, reading not only feeds the mind but also enriches one's personality. Being a wide reader has given me the confidence to converse with different people on a plethora of subjects – from science to trivia, religion to psychology, culture to politics, food to biographies – and much, much more. The art of reading is the art of transforming oneself into a better person.

Reading expands your horizon. You can travel anywhere, be anyone and do anything. Nothing is off-limits.

The written word is a gift waiting to be unwrapped for us all – literally.

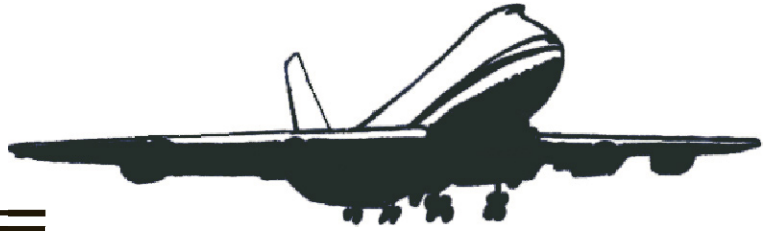

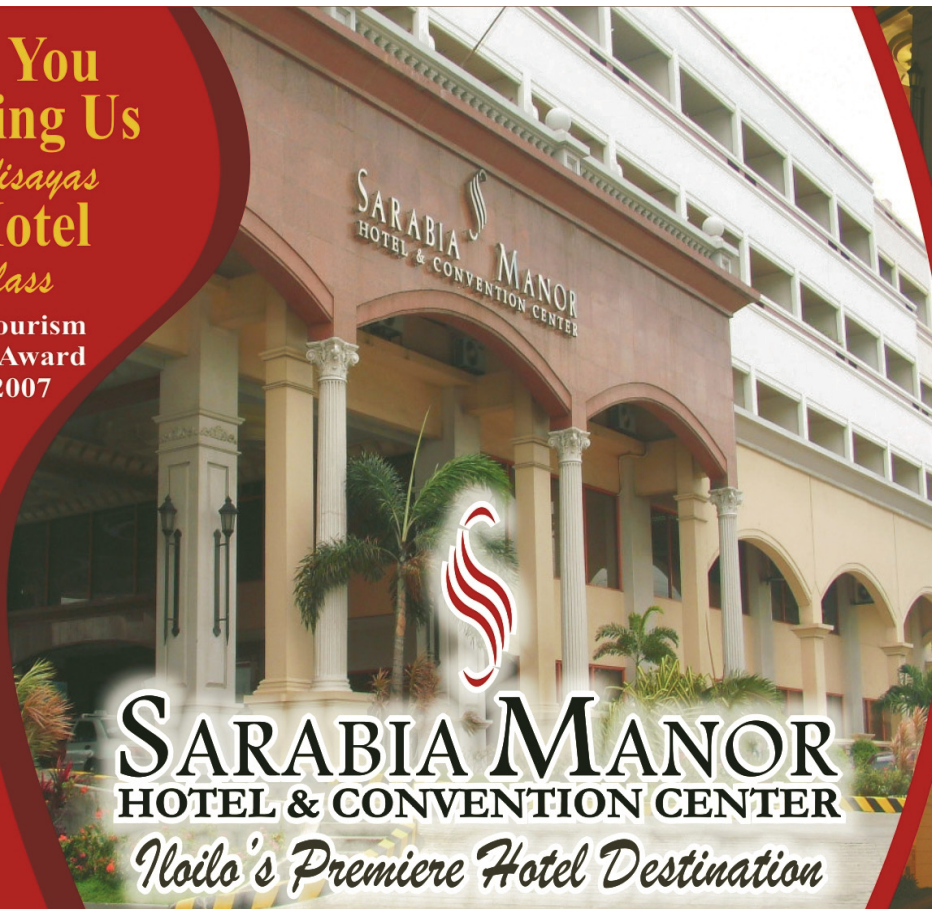
